#### General:

- 1. Halloween Party raised a £134 profit.
- 2. Only 4 people stayed behind to help clean ... It was suggested that all leaders should stay behind to help clean up next year to make for a joint effort including all groups.
- **3.** Tracy Mills priced up the blinds. The prices for unfitted blinds from lowest to highest quote ranged from £54 to £90.

#### Rent:

- 1. Energy supply has been changed from Economy 7 to std.
- 2. Rents are now due for the end of January.
- 3. The cost of energy has necessitated and increase in rent rates. It was proposed and agreed that rates will be increased this year to £300 per group.
- 4. The Hut Account balance stands at £1250.
- 5. Barclay's contribution cheque to the Flower Show revenue hasn't been received yet . Tracy Mills will chase it up.

## Weekly Cleaning:
